Our Vision for Detroit

Dr. Cleamon Moorer's vision for Eye Care For Detroit, Inc. was inspired by his late mother, Mrs. Dorris Jean Moorer, who instilled in him a deep commitment to giving back. Born with congenital cataracts, Dr. Moorer faced significant challenges, becoming legally blind by age 21. His mother's heartfelt plea to the Grace Guild of Sinai-Grace Hospital resulted in a life-changing act of generosity that funded the surgery to restore his vision. Her parting words, "Promise me you'll give back," became his lifelong mission.

During the COVID-19 pandemic, Dr. Moorer's company, American Advantage Home Care, uncovered a critical gap: a lack of accessible, affordable eye care for Detroit's underserved and homebound residents. In response, he founded Eye Care For Detroit in 2022 to combat rising rates of preventable blindness.

This nonprofit unites physicians, donors, and advocates in a shared mission to make vision care a right, not a privilege. Dr. Moorer's call to action is clear: "I care, you care, we all care about the Eye Care of Detroiters." Together, they are ensuring no Detroiter is left behind in the pursuit of clear vision.


